ORDER

AMJAD ALI SAHITO, J:- Through the instant bail application, the applicant/accused

above named seeks his post-arrest bail in Crime No.28 of 2021, under sections 324,

147, 148, 149, 504, 114, 337-A(i), 337-A(iv), 337-F(i), 337-F(vi) 337-L(ii), P.P.C,

registered at P.S Hatri, after his bail plea was declined by the learned IIIrd Additional

Sessions Judge Hyderabad vide order dated 09.06.2021.

2. The details and particulars of the F.I.R. are already available in the bail

application and F.I.R., same could be gathered from the copy of F.I.R. attached with

such application, hence needs not to reproduce the same hereunder.

3. Complainant present and states that due to intervention of the Nekmards the

compromise has been effected between the parties, as such, he has no objection if bail is

granted to the applicant/accused Waheed @ Waheed Ali.

4. Learned Additional Prosecutor General, Sindh submits that since sections in

which the applicant/accused is involved are also compoundable therefore he raised no

objection for grant of bail. Resultantly the instant bail application is allowed and

applicant/accused Waheed @ Waheed Ali is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing

solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and P.R. bond in the like amount to the

satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

5. Needless to mention here that the observations made hereinabove are tentative

in nature and would not influence the learned Trial Court while deciding the case of the

applicant on merits.
