<u>Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J</u>: The cases of the petitioners are that they provided transportation facilities/supply of foods and other facilities to the flood affected Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) at Karachi. The learned counsel for the petitioners argued that the Government had sanctioned the funds for providing these facilities to the affectees. He further argued that partial payments were made but the final bills were not cleared and each individual petitioner has also mentioned the amount in the prayer clause separately for the reimbursement of their all pending dues. On last date of hearing in order to resolve this controversy, we issued notice to the Relief Commissioner. Today Qazi

Shahid Pervez. Senior Member Board of Revenue/Relief Commissioner is present and he submits that the worthy Chief Minister Sindh has already constituted a committee "Chief Minister Inspection Team (CMIT)", where all these issues have already been taken up and the Relief Commissioner undertakes that before the committee members all the petitioners will be provided an opportunity of hearing to produce all relevant record for the purposes of reconciliation and if any pending dues are found to be payable, the same shall be paid to all the petitioners within a period of three months after proper scrutiny of record and reconciliation. Learned counsel for the petitioners is satisfied by this statement and seek disposal on the statement of Relief Commissioner. Order accordingly.
