**Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J.** The initial controversy in this case was that the petitioners were allowed to sit in the MDCAT but their results were not announced. On notice Mr. Zeeshan Abdullah, counsel for the PMC appeared and submitted that the petitioners were never issued any admit card however he admitted that they were allowed to sit in the examination. Counsel for the NTS also admitted that some students were allowed to sit in the examination without admit cards including the petitioners as they were making hue and cry. Since both the petitioners were allowed to appear in the MDCAT therefore we had directed to counsel for the PMC to inquire whether they have passed their examination and why their results were not announced. We also directed PMC counsel to go through the answer sheets to apprise this court.

Today counsel for the PMC, in good faith and to satisfy the petitioners, has himself brought the answer sheets and according to these answer sheets, the petitioner No.1 has obtained 71 marks and petitioner No.2 has obtained 74 marks, whereas, passing marks in the MDCAT were 120. On seeing these answer sheets by the petitioners their counsel is satisfied. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
