Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that all the petitioners submitted their individual applications to the Deputy Commissioner West, Karachi for the award of compensation for loss occurred due to rain fall on 25.08.2020 which has allegedly caused colossal losses to the petitioners' houses but despite giving applications to the Deputy Commissioner West, Karachi in view of the Notification dated 29.08.2020 issued by Relief Commissioner Sindh wherein in para-3 it is clearly mentioned that all the Deputy Commissioner of the districts which have been declared calamity affected shall immediately assess specific losses and move for compensation. When this notification was confronted to the learned AAG as well as Mukhtiarkar Mangohpir, Karachi, they both proposed that some directions may be issued to the Deputy Commissioner West, Karachi to consider the pending applications of the petitioners and pass necessary orders in view of the notification relied on. Learned counsel for the petitioners is satisfied. Petition is disposed of with the directions to the Deputy Commissioner West, Karachi to decide the pending applications of the petitioners within 30 days for further necessary action, if any, in view of the aforesaid Notification.
