Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Learned counsel for the petitioners pointed out page-29 which is an order issued by the Provincial Transport Authority, Government of Sindh on 05.05.2017. He further argued that petitioners are the bus owner but their names are not mentioned in the time schedule. Counsel for the intervener pointed out another order issued by the Provincial Transport Authority on 08.11.2017 which is available at page-41 and argued that notification issued on 05.05.2017 was superseded by this notification which was decided by consent of all stakeholders and name of petitioner No.1 is mentioned at serial No.1 in the time schedule for the upjourney. Learned counsel for the petitioners argued that name of the petitioners No.2 to 4 are not mentioned in any time schedule. Counsel for the intervener pointed out page-49 in which time has already been allocated to the other petitioners also but there is no notification available on record containing the names of these

petitioners. Focal Person, Transport Department is present alongwith Addl. A.G., Sindh and he submits that immediately after Eid holidays they will call a meeting with the petitioners as well as intervener Muhammad Rizwan and resolve the issue with regard to the allocation of time to the vehicles of the petitioners and issue proper notification/order. Petition is disposed of accordingly alongwith pending application. This exercise should be completed within a period of 20 days.
