Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Counsel for the petitioner argued that the contract for construction of cement street of all the wards of Thatta and Makli was awarded to the petitioner and 40% work has been completed but payment was made only with regard to the 10% work. He further argued that remaining 60% work could not be completed due to non-payment of funds. However, the petitioner is willing to complete the work in accordance with the work order provided that payments are made to him. Reply of respondents No.3 and 4 is available on record in which they have agreed the contents of the petition with further excuse that due to shortage of funds, the amount could not be paid while they are making all efforts continuously for the release of funds to complete all the schemes to facilitate the people at earliest. Learned Addl. A.G. submits that some directions may be issued to Deputy Commissioner Thatta to arrange funds according to allocation of funds made for the scheme and after reconciliation of accounts of the petitioner, the deficit payment may be made so that the

scheme may be completed at earliest. Statement of the learned Addl. A.G. is taken on record. Petition is disposed of accordingly with direction to the Deputy Commissioner Thatta to arrange the funds through respondent No.1 and if some amount is liable to be paid to the petitioner the same may be paid within a period of three (03) months for the completion of the scheme in accordance with the work order.
