- 1- That the petitioners who have not opted for compromise/agreement/discharge in favor of NBP are covered by the MTO Scheme and are alike/identical to the respondents in C.A. No. 1644/2013 have been extended the same benefits as per judgment dated 21.09.2016 passed by the Apex Court in C.A. No. 1644/2013.
- 2- It is further submitted that the arrears are being paid in 03 installments instead of 06 installments as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the judgment referred hereinabove.
- 3- In addition to the above, it is further submitted that the final installment shall be made with the salary of December, 2021.
- 4- It is also submitted that if any petitioner feels any grievance in respect of his fixation may make representation to the competent authority of the Bank through proper channel for the rederassal thereof.
