**ORDER**

**Muhammad Junaid Ghaffar, J.** –This Petition has been filed seeking the following prayer(s):-

“a. To direct the respondent No. 6 to 9 to deduct/delete the exorbitant amounting to Rs.63,51,228/- issued to the petitioner in excessive including current bill for the month of October, 2019 to the tune of Rs.1575,096/- and direct them to issue correct bill as per consumption.

b. To direct the respondent No.2 to 5 to conduct concrete inquiry against respondent No.6 to 9 regarding sending excessive/exorbitant bill amounting to Rs. 63,51,228/- along with sanctioned of New connection in presence of earlier connection against the petitioner with further direction them to send correct and accurate bill according to consumption.

c. To direct the respondents to restore the electricity Transformer already installed in the petitioner’s factory which they have illegally removed”.

Today, statement has been filed by the Petitioner’s Counsel, wherein it is stated that various installments have been paid. If that be the case, then the Petitioner has no *locus standi* to challenge the bills as being excessive before this Court.

Accordingly, this Petition being misconceived is hereby **dismissed**.
