At the outset, respondent No.1 contends that she has no objection if this Court modifies the impugned judgment and reduces the maintenance of minor from Rs.5000/- to Rs.3000/- per month if petitioner assures that he, being father, shall cooperate in matter(s) requiring appearance or *signature* of petitioner in relation to document(s)/ record regarding education etc of minor. Counsel for the petitioner, with consultation, of petitioner, agrees and contends that petitioner would provide every assistance and would not cause any disturbance to the respondent No.1 with regard to permanent custody of minor.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of in the following terms, agreed by parties:-

- Impugned judgment is maintained, however, the amount of maintenance is reduced from Rs.5000/- to Rs.3000/- per month.
- 2) Needless to mention that respondent No.1 being mother is guardian of the minor and would be competent to approach any office for the welfare of minor as guardian in person however, petitioner would be bound to render every help with regard to any documentation of minor and would appear in every office as and when

required in preparation of CNIC, B-form, school admission etc.

- 3) Respondent No.1 would be competent to approach the Guardian & Wards Court, if needs so, which would be competent to pass any appropriate order with regard to welfare of minor.
- 4) The petitioner, who is having degree of software engineer earlier to present job, was getting handsome salary, agrees that if he gets any other job with increased salary, he would be bound to pay at least 30% of his salary to the respondent No.1, in case of failure respondent No.1 would be competent to approach proper Court for appropriate that court shall ensure that such condition is fulfilled.
