one Mukhtiarkar which discloses that he is working in the office of

Mukhtiarkar on private basis / need basis and is typing letters of the

officers. This could hardly be a ground for the regularization of his service.

He was never appointed officially and that too through transparent process

required to be adopted while appointing the employees in the revenue

department as we expect that a transparent process through

advertisement should have been made. Although there was no

advertisement but even the appointment of the petitioner is not convincing

at all as only letter at page 45 disclosed that he was privately appointed

typist in the office of Mukhtiarkar.

The petition being misconceived is dismissed.
