2to4. The petitioners were claimed to be employees of MUSTANG respondent No.7 to whom some contracts were awarded by the Provincial Governments. These petitioners were only appointed on daily wages/temporary basis in the year 2019. Petitioners cannot enforce such contractual obligations against Government Officials. In so far as any enforcement of the contract against the private company is concerned, they may exhaust their remedy by approaching the forum having jurisdiction in this regard. Petition being misconceived is dismissed.
