Against an order dated 15th March 2022 passed by the Banking Court-II Hyderabad in Suit No. 341 of 2015 considering an application under Article 84 of Qanun-e-Shahadat Order, 1984 the application was dismissed. Perhaps apparently this is an interlocutory order and that too on an application under Article 84 of Qanun-e-Shahadat Order, 1984. The statute does not provide any remedy of appeal hence such statutory scheme cannot be by-passed by challenging the impugned Order in a petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan. The petitioner, if aggrieved, of the findings of the order and conclusion drawn in the impugned Order may challenge it cumulatively after passing of the final Judgment and Decree if he is so aggrieved. The petition being misconceived is dismissed.
