Through this Petition, the Petitioner seeks protective/transitory bail in Reference No.06 of 2018, enabling her to come from abroad and surrender before the concerned Court to seek pre-arrest bail. Learned Counsel submits that the name of the Petitioner has been arrayed as Accused No.4 in the said Reference and presently she is abroad and is scheduled to return on 29.06.2022 and in support he has referred to Emergency Passport of the Petitioner and ticket reservation available at Pages-29 to 33.

Learned Counsel submits that earlier the Petitioner had approached this Court for the same relief through C.P No.D-3774/2022 and on 16.06.2022, Protective Bail was granted up to 25.06.2022, which has expired as the Petitioner could not obtain a valid Travel Permit/Emergency Passport at UAE, and therefore, this fresh Bail Petition.

Without touching the merits of the case, the Petitioner is admitted to protective/transitory bail in Reference No.06/2018 for

a period Ten (10) days from today subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Lac) and P.R. bond in the like amount. The surety already furnished in C.P No.D-3774/2022 lying with the Nazir shall be accepted as surety for the present purposes. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned Trial Court. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of Ten (10) days from today i.e. 06.07.2022 or when the Petitioner surrenders before the concerned trial Court whichever is earlier.

This Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
