The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution seeking to impugn the vires of the National Counter Terrorism Authority Act, 2013 as infringing Article 19, 19-A, 22 and 28 of the Constitution, with it broadly being alleged that it impedes the Islamic way of life as it seeks to address the mainstreaming of Madressahs as well as the subject of Population Control. Per the Petitioner, NACTA is abusing its authority to undertake Social/Religious/Culture Engineering under the garb of National Security. Be that as it may, the Petitioner has been unable to advance any cogent argument to substantiate her challenge and a perusal of the memo of Petition reflects that the same does not disclose any valid ground justiciable within the scope of Article 199. The Petition, being misconceived, accordingly stands dismissed in limine.
