The applicants/defendants by way of instant Civil Transfer Application under Section 24 CPC has sought for transfer of his F.C.Suit No.23 of 2013 re: Mst. Sakina and others v. Khan Muhammad and others from the Court of learned Senior Civil Judge, Mirpur Mathelo-Ghotki to any competent Court in district Sukkur mainly for the reasons that the attitude of learned Presiding Officer of learned trial Court is very harsh towards the applicants, therefore, applicants have lost faith upon learned Presiding Officer to get the justice.

On being asked, as to on what date, learned Presiding Officer used harsh words with the applicants party? No satisfactory reply to it was furnished by learned counsel for the applicants. Mere apprehension in the mind of applicants that they would not get justice at the hands of learned Presiding Officer is no ground for transfer of the case. Apprehension must be reasonable and the reasonableness is to be decided at the peculiar facts and circumstances of each case. No cogent reason or proof has been placed on record by the learned counsel for the applicants, hence all the contentions are totally misconceived and contrary to law.

Consequently, the instant Civil Transfer Application along with listed applications being misconceived stands dismissed in limine.
