- This is a Suit for Damages, Declaration and Permanent 3. Injunction. Learned Counsel for the plaintiff submits that the plaintiff entered into a Lease Agreement in respect of property bearing House No. 12, Street 43, F-7/1, Islamabad, owned by defendant No.1 through defendant No.2 who is her husband. Per learned Counsel the lease stands completed / terminated and initially possession of the property was refused, however, subsequently, it has been handed over to defendant No.1, whereas, the defendants have raised frivolous objections in respect of alleged damage to the property as well missing items from the property. He further submits several E-mails took exchange between the parties in respect of the alleged dispute raised by defendants, however, now defendants are maligning the plaintiff by creating a Social Media Page against the Plaintiff-Company and its officials. In support he has referred to Annexure P/12 available at Page 59 to 61. Per learned Counsel the plaintiff had always been agreeable to settle the issue, without prejudice, but defendants are still continuing with their malicious campaign and have even approached the Italian Embassy in this regard. He submits that if defendants have any genuine grievance in respect of the lease of the property in question,

then they can only adopt measures in accordance with law, but not through these tactics of black mailing on Social Media. Counsel submits that such conduct of defendants is damaging the reputation of plaintiff, hence this Suit.

Let notice be issued for a date to be fixed by the Office in the 4th week of August, 2016. Till then the defendants are restrained from harassing the plaintiff's officials and from writing letters or E-mails or otherwise using Social Media by making statements to third parties raising false allegations against the plaintiff and or setting up media pages maligning the plaintiff company and or its officials.
