The grievance of the petitioner appears to be that the respondents have issued seizure Notice U/S 168(1) of the Customs Act to M/s. Vital Trade International (Pvt) Ltd., whose goods are lying in the custody of the petitioner, whereas, the petitioner has also been directed not to remove the seized goods except without their permission. Counsel initially contended that respondents are causing harassment and since petitioner is not interested in the goods, except for the charges which the owner of the goods was liable to pay, therefore respondents be directed to remove the goods if they have been seized accordingly.

On the other hand Mr. Kashif Nazeer has affected appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and has filed comments and submits that no harassment is being caused whereas, the goods in question have been seized, which are likely to be confiscated after the adjudication proceedings and would be further dealt with in accordance with law.

Be that as it may, in case the proceedings initiated by the respondents are not concluded within 45 days, the respondents would make necessary arrangements for removal of goods and in case the goods are auctioned, the petitioner would be entitled to claim its charges in terms of Section 201 (d) of the Customs Act, 1969.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms along with the listed application.
