By consent of the present, it is decided that to ensure maximum benefits as may be available to the petitioner in these proceedings the interest of the respondent-bank shall be secured by way of Rs.22,02,722.00 (from the amount deposited and claimed against the petitioner by the bank) being got invested in some profit bearing government scheme by the Additional Registrar of this Court, interest / profit thereof shall be payable to the petitioner. Apart from the foregiven the balance amount of outstanding of his retirement / pension benefits shall be available to him for which the break-up shall be provided by the respondent-bank to the Additional Registrar. From the amount deposited by the respondent-bank, the balance shall be disbursed by the Additional Registrar directly, whereas, the balance available with the bank if any shall be payable by the respondent-bank directly to the petitioner. The petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the claim of the respondent-bank by way of proceedings as available to him in accordance with law, which are not coming under the ambit of this Constitutional proceedings. In case the petitioner prefers not to challenge the claim of the bank the amount secured shall be available to the petitioner on the adjustment of the loans as are said to have been got financed by the petitioner during his service/claim of the bank.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
