## <u>ORDER</u>

**Agha Faisal**, J. The petitioner, claiming to represent an ethnicity, has *inter alia* called into question the entire recruitment in the Port Qasim Authority with effect from 2007 and has further sought a restraint upon any further recruitment therein on the bald accusation that all such recruitment is in violation of a *quota*.

2. On the very first date of hearing<sup>1</sup> the petitioner was confronted as to the maintainability hereof, *inter alia*, on the grounds that he was admittedly not an aggrieved person and neither any policy / quota had been placed before the Court nor demonstrable instance/s of any infringement. No satisfactory answer in such regard was provided on the said date or today; instead the petitioner confined his response to salacious bigoted refrains, *prima facie* prejudicial to the comity of the nation and unworthy of being dignified in the writ jurisdiction of this Court.

3. In view hereof, we find this petition to be misconceived, hence, the same, along with pending application/s, was dismissed with costs vide our short order announced in Court at the conclusion of the hearing. These are the reasons for our short order.
