<u>O R D E R</u>

ADNAN-UL-KARIM MEMON, J:- At the outset, Miss Samina Ajmeeri learned counsel for the petitioners seeks disposal of the instant petition in terms that minor namely Baby Khushi has been handed over to the petitioners thus the purpose of filling of the instant petition has been served. She while briefing the case, explained that respondent No.1 is the father of minor namely Baby Khushi, who is aged about five years; however, the custody of minor has been kept by the petitioners who are the real maternal grandfather and grandmother as her father was facing trial for allegedly murdering his wife on 11.11.2017 in Crime No. 156 of 2017 and he now wants to give away said Baby Khushi to somebody else in gratification but learned appellate Court did not consider these aspects of the case and dismissed the Guardian Appeal of the petitioners while maintaining the order of learned trial Court whereby the Guardianship application of the respondent No.1 was allowed ignoring the welfare of minor who has no affinity with her father who allegedly murdered her mother.

In view of the statement of learned counsel, this petition stands disposed of in terms that the custody of minor namely Baby Khushi has already been given to the petitioners being grandfather and grandmother of the minor, thus no further interference is required at the end of this court.
