**YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J.** The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution, raising an allegation of harassment against the Respondents, being the Federation of Pakistan, through its Secretary, Establishment Division, Islamabad, National Accountability of Bureau, through its Chairman, Director General of the said Bureau, Director Land, Karachi Development Authority (KDA), Karachi and Mukhtiarkar, Ferozabad, District East, Karachi.

However, a perusal of the Petition reflects the pleadings to be completely vague, evasive, and bereft of elucidation as to any particular offending act on the part of any one or more those Respondents. The prayers advanced are also couched in general terms and do not seek to assail any order, notice or definite action. On query posed in that regard, learned counsel for the Petitioner was found wanting and merely fell back on the assertion that certain unknown officials claiming to be the functionaries of the Karachi Development Authority (KDA), Karachi, had threatening to dispossess the Petitioner from his immovable property and correspondence had been addressed through counsel to the Director Land as well as the Mukhtiarkar in that regard. Under the given circumstances, we are of the view that the matter does not present a fit case for consideration in a Constitutional proceeding and if the Petitioner has any apprehension that he may be dispossessed, he may approach the concerned Civil Court having jurisdiction in the matter. That being so, while granting the application for urgency, we hereby dismiss the Petition *in limine*, along with the other miscellaneous application.
