<u>ORDER</u>

Agha Faisal, **J**. The petitioner, ostensibly an unconcerned citizen, has assailed a notification dated 26.09.2022, whereby the respondent no. 14 was transferred / posted. At the very onset, learned counsel was confronted as to the maintainability hereof, *inter alia*, in view the petitioner being demonstrably devoid of any *locus standi*.

- 2. The counsel remained unable to demonstrate any right of the petitioner enabling him to approach this Court. The allegations against the concerned respondent, albeit bald and unsubstantiated, could not be entertained in the writ jurisdiction in any event as adjudication of disputed questions of fact, requiring detailed inquiry, appreciation of evidence etc., is unmerited¹.
- 3. In view hereof, we find this petition to be misconceived, hence, the same, along with pending application/s, was dismissed *in limine* vide our short order announced in Court at the conclusion of the hearing earlier today. These are the reasons for our short order.
