It is alleged that applicant was arrested and allegedly was found in possession of 1030 grams charas but nothing has been brought on record to show whether it was gross or net weight of the alleged recovered narcotics. In the case of **Aya Khan vs. The State (2020 SCMR 350)**, the Hon'ble Apex Court granted bail to an accused person where the quantity of recovered contraband was closer to the borderline limit of sections 9(b) and 9(c) of the CNSA, 1997. Besides, the applicant is behind the bars since his arrest i.e. 20.09.2022. It is well settled that mere gravity or heinousness of an alleged offence is not sufficient to keep a person facing trial behind the bars indefinitely. No other case of like nature has ever been registered against the applicant.

- 2. In view of above, the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail, subject to his furnishing solvent surety in sum of Rs.50,000/- [Rupees Fifty Thousand Only] and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
- 3. The observations made hereinabove are of tentative nature and the learned trial Court will not influence with the same while deciding the case on its own merits.
