ORDER

YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J. The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution in relation to the Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry (“FPCCI”), praying as follows:-

- A. Declare that the impugned act of hanging picture of the lost candidate/ the Respondent No. 4 opposed to the returned candidate/ the Petitioner against the post of Senior Vice President (SVP) for the elections held in year 2020 in the Federation House by the Respondent No. 2 is illegal, unlawful, unconstitutional, mala fide and void ab initio;
- B. Declare that the act of Respondent No. 2 in hanging the picture of the lost candidate/Respondent No. 4 against the post of Senior Vice President of the Respondent No. 2 is illegal and unlawful and in violation of the established practice;

- C. Direct the Respondents to hang the picture/ achievement frame of the Petitioner in line with the other elected representatives of the FPCCI who have been duly elected by the members of the FPCCI for the elections held in year 2020;
- D. Pass *ad interim* orders directing the Respondent No. 2 from removing the picture of the lost candidate/ the Respondent No. 4 till final disposal of the instant petition;
- E. Grant Costs.”

As it apparent, no order of the Director General of Trade Organizations has been impugned and the subject of Petition is one that does not fall within the parameters of Article 199 of the constitution.

Under the circumstances, the Petition is found to be misconceived. Hence while granting the application for urgency we hereby dismiss the Petition in *limine* along with the other pending miscellaneous applications.
