Mr. Ghulam Abbas Akhtar files statement on behalf of respondent No.3 together with comments and Vakalatnama, same is taken on record.

Petitioner claims employment in Pakistan Railway on the basis of deceased/son quota on the ground that his father was serving in Pakistan Railway and has passed away, while being in service. The respondents filed their parawise comments whereby they did not dispute the claim of the petitioner, however, they asserted that neither petitioner has applied for any post nor approached them in respect of his grievance.

Mr. Ghulam Abbas learned counsel for respondents submits that respondents have invited application for various posts, whereby 20% seat have been reserved for sons/legal heirs of deceased employees, thereby the petitioner's case will be considered provided he submits his application along with his testimonials within stipulated time.

Mr. Suhail Ahmed Khoso learned counsel for the petitioner's instructions states that petitioner has passed SSC examination and he will approach the respondents through application.

Since the petitioner's claim is with regard to his employment in Pakistan Railway on the basis of deceased/son quota is not disputed by respondents, however, they have categorically contended that he will

considered according to policy provided that he submits his application and testimonials within time. In view of above, we dispose of instant petition with directions to the respondents to consider the case of petitioner in terms of quota reserved for the sons of deceased employees.
