Services of the petitioner, who was appointed as Computer Operator on temporary basis and worked as such from 2005 to 2009, have not been regularized by the respondents and/or he has not been treated at par with the other employees, who were employed in similar fashion inasmuch as they have been issued fresh orders of appointment but he has been deprived of it, notwithstanding his performance was up to the mark and no complainant was ever made against him from any quarter. Such grievance has culminated in filing of instant Petition with the prayer of its redressal.

In comments, the above assertion has not been refuted. Even, Dr. Abdul Hameed Chaner, Regional Director (Colleges). Suitkur, present in Court, has confirmed the factum. He, nonetheless, stated that the other similarly placed employees have been re-appointed.

In view of above this background, we are of the considered view that the petitioner also deserves the treatment, given to other similarly placed employees. Consequently, we direct the respondents to treat the petitioner like the other employees, who have been appointed through fresh appointment orders. This exercise shall be completed within a month.

Petition stands disposed of.
