Petitioners and private respondents are at daggers drawn in respect of immovable property left by late Meharuddin who happened to be father of the petitioners as well as respondent No 2 and it is also stated that private respondents have filed civil suit which is pending adjudication before Senior Civil Judge, Moro. Grievance of the petitioners is that they are being harassed by respondent No.2 who is their real sister and instead of providing protection, official respondents with the connivance of private respondents are also causing harassment to the petitioners. it is further alleged that private respondents are creating panic and harassment to the petitioners by moving false and baseless complaints/applications before official respondents.

Mr. Gianchan Keswani, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 did not controvert the contentions of learned counsel for petitioner to the extent that parties are involved in civil litigation and they are close relatives inter se.

In the given circumstances when matter is subjudice before competent Court of law, we dispose of this petition along with the listed application and direct the respondents not to cause any sort of harassment to the petitioners under the pretext of any false or fabricated application. Meanwhile parties may pursue their remedy before proper forum.
