Amjad Ali Sahito, J:- This is an application for restoration of instant crimianl revision application, which was dismissed on account of non-prosecution vide order dated 17.12.2019. The criminal revision application was filed against the order dated 14.02.2013, passed by learned Special Judge, Anti-Corruption (Provincial) Hyderabad @ Camp Dadu, whereby the application under section 249 Cr.P.C. filed by the applicant Muhammad Bux Mallah and others in crime No.02/2008 registered at PS ACE Dadu for the offence under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 477-A/34 PPC r/w section 5 (2) Prevention of Corruption Act, 1947, was dismissed.

- 2. Progress report has been received from the learned trial Court and as per report, the case of the applicant / accused and two others has been bifurcated, however, two accused namely Abdul Qadir and Muhammad Ayoub have absconded away and NBWs have been issued against them. Learned counsel states that he would be satisfied, if the case of applicant / accused is bifurcated and concluded within a reasonable time. Learned D.P.G. Sindh has raised no objection to the above proporal.
- In view of the above, learned trial Court is directed to bifurcate the case of applicant / accused and conclude it within a period of three (03) months in accordance with law. However, the applicant / accused would be at liberty to repeat application under section 249-A Cr.P.C. in case, if the trial is not concluded within the stipulated time.
- **4.** Instant miscellaneous application being MA No.1583/2022 stands disposed of in the above terms.
