The petitioners claim to be beneficiaries of an award rendered by Commissioner Workmen's Compensation Authority under the Payment of Wages Act, Hyderabad. The present petition *prima facie* seeks enforcement of that award in writ jurisdiction and directions are against the Deputy Commissioner and Mukhtiarkar to recover the awarded amount.

At the very outset, learned counsel confronted with respect to maintainability hereof as this Court does not act as the executing Court for the Commissioner Workmen's Compensation and Authority<sup>1</sup>. Learned counsel remained unable to satisfy the court on such count.

In view hereof, while the petitioner remains at liberty to avail remedy and recourse before the forum having concerned jurisdiction, no case is made out for invocation of the writ jurisdiction of this Court. Petition stands dismissed along with pending application/s.
