4. On arrest from the applicant has been secured 2300 grams of charas by the police party of P.S Wada Machhyoon, for that he was booked and reported upon by the police. On refusal of bail by the learned Sessions Judge, Khairpur, the applicant has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant application under section 497 Cr.P.C.

Heard arguments and perused the record.

As per FIR, on arrest of the applicant has been secured 2300 grams of Charas. In that situation it would be premature to say that the applicant being innocent has been involved in this case falsely by the police by foisting upon him such recovery. No doubt there is no independent witness to the incident, but for this reason, the complainant and his witnesses could not be disbelieved at this stage particularly when they are not found to be having ill-will or malafide with the applicant to involve him in this case falsely by foisting upon him Charas, with positive report of chemical examiner. The minimum sentence prescribed by law for the alleged offence by way of Amendment is 09 years. The offence alleged against the applicant is affecting the society at large. There appear reasonable grounds to believe that the applicant is guilty of the offence, with which he is charged; thus, no case for his release on bail on point of further inquiry is made out.

Consequent upon above discussion, the instant bail application is dismissed, with direction to learned trial Court to expedite the disposal of very case against the applicant preferably within two months, after receipt of copy of this order.
