Irshad Ali Shah, J. It is alleged that on arrest from the applicant was secured 12000 grams of Bhang by police party of Police Station, Shaheed Murtza Mirani for that he was booked and reported upon. On having been refused bail by learned Ist Additional Sessions Judge/(MCTC), Special Judge for (CNS) Khairpur, the applicant has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant application u/s 497, Cr.P.C.

- 2. Heard arguments and perused the record.
- 3. There is no independent witness to the incident. Only 1000 grams of Bhang has been subjected to Chemical examination; therefore the liability of the applicant, if any would be only to that extent only. The minimum sentence prescribed by law is seven years. The case has finally been challaned. There is no apprehension of tampering with the evidence on the part of applicant. In these circumstances the case for the release of applicant on bail on point of further enquiry is made out.
- 4. In view of above, the applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing surety in sum of Rs.50,000/- and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
- 5. The instant bail application is disposed of accordingly together with listed application.
