Irshad Ali Shah, J. It is alleged that the applicant by fabricating false documents with regard to allotment of the flats at labour colony Sukkur obtained in all rupees fourteen lacs from complainant Mst. Shamim and others and then threatened them to be killed when they went to him for return of their money, for that the present case was registered.

- 2. On having been refused post arrest bail by learned IInd Additional Sessions Judge/Gender Based Violence Court, Sukkur; the applicant has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant Crl. Bail Application under section 497 Cr.P.C.
- 2. Heard arguments and perused the record.
- 3. Apparently, the applicant was having no authority to make allotment of the flats in labour colony Sukkur. When the money was paid to the applicant by the complainant and others? It is not made known. The offence alleged against the applicant is not falling within prohibitory clause. The case has finally been challaned and there is no likelihood of absconsion or tempering with the evidence on part of the applicant. In these circumstance; a case for release of the applicant on bail, on point of further inquiry obviously is made out.
- 5. In view of above the applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
- 6. The instant bail application is disposed of accordingly.
