IRSHAD ALI SHAH, J;-It is alleged that the applicants in furtherance of their common intention caused lathi blows to complainant Allah Bachayo, for that the present case was registered.

2. The applicants on having been refused pre-arrest bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge/MCTC, Ubauro have sought for the same from this Court by way of instant bail application under Section 498-A, Cr.P.C.

3. Heard arguments and perused record.

4. The FIR of the incident has been lodged with delay of about 14 days; such delay having not been explained plausibly could not be over looked. The injuries sustained by the complainant are not falling with the prohibitory clause. The parties apparently were having grudge with each other over cattle trespass. The case has finally been challaned. The applicants have joined the trial and there is no allegation of misusing the concession of interim pre-arrest bail on their part. In these circumstances a case for grant of pre-arrest bail to the applicants on point of further inquiry and malafide is made out.

In view of above, the interim pre-arrest bail already granted to the applicants is confirmed on same terms and conditions.

Instant Bail Application is disposed of accordingly.
