MUHAMMAD KARIM KHAN AGHA J.- Applicant Riaz Ahmed has been booked in Crime No.98 of 2023 registered at P.S Talhar under Sections 324, 114, 147, 148, 149, 504 and 337-F(iii) PPC. He had applied for pre-arrest bail before learned IInd Additional Sessions Judge Badin (trial Court), however, same was declined vide Order dated 31.08.2023, hence he has approached this Court for pre-arrest bail.

2. Brief facts of the case as per FIR lodged by complainant Master Gul Muhammad are that complainant party had a dispute with accused party and according to complainant on 3.06.2023 present applicant and co-accused came to the complainant party and on account of dispute attacked upon them with various weapons, which led to injuries to three persons from the complainant side.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.P.G as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have perused the record.

4. It appears that FIR has been lodged with promptitude naming the present applicant with specific role of causing firearm injuries to three persons namely Muhammad Urs, Abdul Aziz and Lutufullah and the said injuries are supported by the medical certificate. It is noted that it was a daylight incident and complainant party knew the accused party, as such there is no question of mistaken identity. It is also noted that Section 161 Cr.P.C statements of above said injured persons duly support the contents of FIR. The offences, for which the applicant has been charged, are non-bailable and I do not find any allegation of malafide against complainant in this case. Since sufficient material is available on record, which connects the present applicant with the commission of offence, as such interim pre-arrest bail granted to him vide Order dated 05.09.2023 is hereby

recalled. However learned trial Court/IInd Additional Sessions Judge Badin is directed to expedite the trial and complete it within four (04) months from the date of this Order in accordance with law.

5. Needless to mention here that observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and will not prejudice the case of either party at trial.

6. Captioned bail application stands disposed of accordingly.
