The appellant by way of instant appeal has impugned the order of the Returning Officer whereby his nomination paper to contest election from PS-24 (Sukkur-III) has been rejected for the reason that he has failed to declare the value of assets. If Returning Officer was having a feeling that the declaration of the value of the property was necessary then, she ought to have provided a chance to the appellant to do the needful as is prescribed by section 62 (9) (d) (ii) of Election Act-2017. The right to contest election could not be denied for technical reasons. As such the impugned order could not be sustained; consequently the nomination paper of the appellant shall be deemed to have been accepted.

The instant Election Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
