Irshad Ali Shah, **J**;- It is alleged that the applicant attempted to commit rape with baby Farah Naz a girl aged about 07 years, for that the present case was registered.

- 2. The applicants on having been refused post arrest bail by learned IVth Additional Sessions Judge/Gender Based Violence Court, Khairpur, have sought for the same from this Court by way of instant Bail Application u/s 497 Cr.P.C.
- 3. Heard arguments and perused the record.
- 4. The FIR of the incident has been lodged with delay of about two days; such delay having not been explained plausibly could not be over looked; it is reflecting consultation and deliberation. It is case of mere attempt to commit rape; same if is examined in the light dispute between the parties over sale and purchase of the property is appearing to be doubtful. The case has finally be challaned and there is no likelihood of absconsion or tempering with the evidence on the part of the applicant. In these circumstances the case for the release of applicant on bail on point of further enquiry is made out.
- 5. In view of above, the applicant is admitted to bail subject to their furnishing solvent surety in sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
- 6. The instant bail application is disposed of accordingly together with listed application.
