<u>ORDER</u>

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO, J.: Allegedly when complainant

spotted marks of violence on dead body of her mother living with her

brother Ali Gohar Dharejo, she suspected that she was murdered by her

sister-in-law/wife of her brother and her friend Younis Ali Bhatti, she

filed an application before the Justice of Peace for registration of FIR

and ultimately lodged the same nominating applicant to be accomplice

of her sister-in-law, namely, Sumera.

2. FIR was registered after three months of the incident and on

examination of dead body which was at advanced age of putrefaction,

no external injury was found. In any case, after preliminary enquiry and

the investigation, the case was challaned and the applicant was

arrested on 28.07.2022 and is in jail.

3. Learned counsel for applicant has pleaded for bail on the ground

of further enquiry, whereas, learned counsel for complainant has

opposed it. Learned Additional P.G has, however, submitted that this is a case of further enquiry, as *prima facie* sufficient evidence connecting applicant with the offence is lacking. I do not see any reason to disagree with him. FIR is delayed by more than three months without a *prima facie* reasonable explanation and except a word of complainant that applicant is accomplice of the main accused, no other evidence has been collected against him in the investigation.

- 4. Accordingly, this bail application is **allowed** and applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.200,000/- (Two Lac) with P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
- 5. The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and shall not influence the trial Court while deciding the case on merits.
