MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO, J.- Complainant is a Watchman working in Municipal Committee, Khairpur, he was posted on water supply adjacent to village Khushkh. On 15.08.2023 on account of an emergency, he left his duty and went to his home. When he returned to the duty place in the morning on 16.08.2023, he found that three Coils of an electricity transformer were stolen. He communicated such information to the concerned officer, later on, he came to know that applicants along with other co-accused named in the FIR had committed the theft. Hence FIR.

2. Learned DPG has conceded to confirmation of bail on the ground that role of complainant itself is suspicious that he without informing any of the officials, had left the place of his duty and came there only on the next day. Further, he has not revealed the source whereby he came to know about the involvement of the applicants. More so, there is delay of six days in registration of FIR.

3. Accordingly in view of above facts and circumstances, both the bail applications are allowed. The interim pre-arrest bail already granted to applicants vide orders dated 20.09.2023 and 21.09.2023, respectively, is hereby confirmed on same terms and conditions. They are directed to attend the trial Court regularly.

4. The observations made herein above are tentative in nature and will not prejudice the case of either party at the trial.
