4&5. The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this court under Article 199 of the Constitution, impugning the Order made by the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation & Authority Hyderabad on 23.2.2024 in Case No. 235 of 2023, so as to allow the application moved by the Respondent No.1 under Section 15(2&3) of Sindh Payment of Wages Act, 2015. As it transpires, the impugned Order is appealable under Section 17 of the aforementioned Act and, on a query posed, counsel for the Petitioner conceded that an Appeal had infact been filed in the matter. However, he argued that the Petitioner had preferred this Petition seeking determination of a jurisdictional point. Needless to say, the Petitioner cannot sail in two boats at the same time and all the points sought to be agitated in the matter may be raised before the appellate forum.

Under the circumstances, the Petition is found to be misconceived and is accordingly dismissed in *limine* along with pending applications.
