After arguing the matter at some length and while 1-4 confronted as to maintainability of instant petition, whereby, petitioner has sought unblocking of CNIC, which appears to have been blocked pursuant to Court's order dated 16.05.2022 passed by the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge, Malir in I.D. Complaint No. 22/2010 [Re: Bijnor Cooperative Housing Society v. Muhammad Siddique & others], whereas, it appears that the said order has not been assailed before the appropriate forum by the petitioner so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has filed an application before the VIth Additional District & Sessions Judge, Malir, in the aforesaid complaint seeking unblocking of the CNIC by recalling the order as according to learned counsel, petitioner has neither illegally occupied the subject property, nor is a party in the aforesaid proceedings, therefore, requests that the learned trial Court may be directed to decide the aforesaid application of the petitioner at an early date.

Accordingly, instant petition stands disposed of with the directions to the petitioner to approach the relevant forum seeking recalling/modifying the order pursuant to which, CNIC of the petitioner has been blocked, whereas, it is expected that such forum/Court may decide such application/appeal of the petitioner

at an early date after hearing the parties in accordance with law and in case of further grievance, the petitioner will be at liberty to seek further remedy as may be available in accordance with law.

Instant petition stands disposed of in the above terms alongwith listed applications.
