ORDER

Counsel for appellant concedes that appellant would submit a tangible security in the sum of Rs.800,000/-(Eight Lac) with the Executing Court if the matter is heard *de novo* and an opportunity is provided to him to lead his evidence.

Attorney of respondent No.1 is present in person and states that if the payment is made within ten days with the Executing Court, he has no objection to the grant of such prayer.

In the circumstances, instant 1st Civil Appeal is **disposed of** with directions to the appellant to submit a tangible security in the sum of Rs.8,00,000/-(Eight Lac) with the Executing Court and upon doing so, the trial Court would hear defence of appellant and upon doing so, rewrite the judgment in accordance with law. In the circumstances, impugned judgment would be set aside. Let needful be done as maintained above. If the appellant fails to comply with this Court's order, after ten days instant appeal will stand dismissed and the Executing Court to proceed against the appellant in accordance with law.

Instant 1st Civil Appeal is **disposed of** in the above terms.
