By way of instant petition, it is stated by the petitioner that the respondents be directed to restore the electric supply to his house in terms of Ombudsman's order and not to force him to deposit wrong bills. The SEPCO is the Company with non-existing rules, it is supplying the electricity to its customers on payment, if such supply is disconnected by the SEPCO then possibly it may be on account of non-payment of such bills. Even otherwise, the dispute with regard to issuance of bills towards consumption of electricity being wrong or genuine being factual, is not amendable to writ jurisdiction of this Court.

In view of above, the instant petition being misconceived is dismissed in limine.
