**ZULFIQAR ALI SANGI, J.-** Applicant seeks post-arrest bail in Crime No.416/2023 registered at P.S. A-Section Dadu after his bail was declined by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-IV Dadu vide order dated 10.02.2024.

- 2. The contents of FIR need not to be reproduced as the same are already mentioned in the memo of bail application.
- 3. Complainant and his counsel present submit that they have no objection if the post-arrest bail is granted to the applicant.
- 4. However, APG has opposed the bail on the ground that the offence for which complainant has given no objection is not compoundable and there appears sufficient material against the present applicant for dismissal of his bail application.
- 5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.
- 6. From the perusal of material available on record, it reflects that as per FIR the incident took place on 07.03.2023 however the FIR was registered on 18.12.2023 after a delay of more than nine months and same has not been explained. Today, complainant present in person raised no objection for grant of bail to the applicant. The non-explanation of delay in the instant case is sufficient to enlarge the applicant on bail.
- 7. Under these circumstances, the bail application is allowed and the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100.000/- and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Trial Court.
