<u>ORDER</u>

Adnan Iqbal Chaudhry J. - Urgency granted. Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions.

The Petitioners are aggrieved of a show-cause notice dated 09.10.2024 published in a newspaper calling upon a number of employees of the Karachi Development Authority, including the Petitioners, to show-cause against alleged unlawful appointments. Admittedly, the Petitioners have yet to file a reply to the show-cause notice and the allegation has yet to be determined. It has been held by the Supreme Court in *Commissioner Inland Revenue v. Jehangir Khan Tareen* (2022 SCMR 92) that a show-cause notice was a structured process to provide a fair chance to a person to respond to allegations against him, and that interference in writ jurisdiction at such a premature stage was not warranted unless the show-cause notice itself was barred by law or an abuse of the process of law. The Petitioners do not make out a case of such interference. The petition is therefore dismissed *in limine*.
