<u>ORDER</u>

<u>Adnan Iqbal Chaudhry J</u>. - The Petitioner, a retired employee of the KMC Medical Department seeks a writ against dispossession from a quarter allotted to her by the Department whilst in service.

Admittedly, the Petitioner retired from service a long time ago, and therefore has no legal basis to retain the accommodation provided by the Department. The fall-back argument of the Petitioner is that she has made an application to the Department to allot the quarter to her ex-husband, who is an employee with the DMC Central, so that her daughters can continue to reside thereat. However, learned counsel for the Petitioner has not been able to show to us the Accommodation Rules under which such a facility is available to the Petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
