Counsel for respondents-EOBI submits that presently working 65 employees will be given EOBI cards effective from 22.02.1992 and all those ex-employees receiving EOBI pension either themselves or such pension being paid to their legal heirs/survivors will be paid arrears w.e.f. 22.02.1992 within two weeks.

Counsel for respondent No.5-FFC files statement and submits that they have provided all requisite amounts to the EOBI. Not only so, they have also paid penalty of Rs.3,002,099/- being arrears on PR-02 A Form, Counsel for EOBI confirms receiving above Form as well as arrears being credited into their account. Counsel for respondents No.3&4 also files statement acknowledging FFC having deposited the sum of Rs.3,002,099/- on 04.11.2024, as statutory increase.

The Court has further been informed by counsel for respondents No.3&4 that besides whatever stated above, he undertakes that EOBI will change the date of joining of all petitioners effective from

22.02.1992 and if any CNIC etc. is needed, such formalities would be completed within three weeks.

The Court has further been informed that at the moment, families of 24 employees are receiving surviving pension by EOBI, whose list has been furnished and arrears of the pensioners occurring from 22.02.1992 will also be paid to them within two weeks.

The Court has been informed that all those petitioners who have not approached EOBI for registering themselves (19 at the moment) will approach EOBI for such purpose. Counsel for petitioners to ensure that those employees to approach EOBI so that formalities are completed within three weeks.

The Court is also informed that 65 employees are still working with FFC, to whom EOBI cards will be issued to them from the date of their joining being 22.02.1992.

It has been re-confirmed to the Court that those employees receiving EOBI benefits either themselves or through their legal heirs/survivors will be eligible to receive such pensionery benefits/arrears w.e.f. 22.02.1992.

With these covenants and undertakings, this petition is **disposed of** accordingly.
