Through the instant Constitutional Petition, petitioners have

prayed for the following reliefs :-

- That, this Honourable Court may be pleased to call upon a) respondent No.1, and so also private respondents restraining them from taking law into their hands and causing harassment to the petitioner party in any manner.
- That, this Honourable Court may further be pleased to direct b) respondents No.1 and 2, to provide adequate protection of law to the life, liberty, property and honour of the petitioner and his other close relatives.
- That, this Honourable Court may further be pleased to direct the c) official respondents to take action under chapter proceedings against private respondents, and report the matter to concerned Magistrate having jurisdiction for executing bond with or without sureties for the purpose of keeping peace and good behaviour.

2. Notices were issued to the respondents as well as Addl. A. G. Comments have been filed by respondents No.1 & 2, in which it is stated that official respondents are prepared to provide protection to the petitioners if and when needed. Comments have also been filed by respondents No.4, 6 and 8, who are being represented by Mr. Habibullah G. Ghouri, advocate. They have also stated that no harassment whatsoever has been caused to the petitioners, nor petitioners shall be harassed in future. Inspite of that, Mr. Shahbaz Ali Brohi, learned advocate for the petitioners submits that SSP may be directed to provide protection to the petitioners.

3. It is ordered that SSP, Jacobabad shall provide protection to the petitioners in accordance with law. He shall ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners. Such report shall be submitted by the SSP after every three months for one year through the Additional Registrar of

this Court.

Instant petition stands accordingly disposed of. 4.
