Through the instant Constitutional Petition, Mst. Mahmooda

petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs :-

- a) That this Honourable Court may graciously be pleased to restrain the respondent No.1 from causing harassment for the petitioner and he may be directed to file such affidavit for not harassing to the petitioner and her family members.
- b) To direct the respondent No.2 to provide legal protection to the life and the liberty of the petitioner and save her from the high handedness of private respondents.
- c) That this Honourable Court may further be pleased to call the private respondents No.3 to 5 and restrain them from causing harassment to the petitioner and her family members.
- d) Award costs of the petition.
- e) Any other equitable relief be granted to the petitioner.

Notices were issued to the respondents as well as Addl. A.G. Comments have been filed by the respondents No.1 & 2.

In the comments, it is stated that neither petitioner has been harassed, nor petitioner shall be harassed in future. Official respondents have stated that they are constitutionally bound to provide legal protection to the petitioner. Learned State Counsel present in the Court also undertakes that every protection as provided in law shall be provided to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Learned advocate for the petitioner is satisfied from such statements as well as undertaking given by learned State Counsel and does not press the instant Constitutional Petition more. The same is accordingly disposed of.
