In furtherance of this Court's order dated 15.10.2024, a compliance report has been furnished by Mr. Safdar Kamal, Legal Advisor, NADRA to show that Mst. Tania is daughter of Sher Dil and her mother name is Mst. Kareema. In fact, Mst. Kareema was employee of Respondent-STEVTA whose pensionary benefits are not being released in favour of the petitioner, who is her unmarried daughter as claimed.

This Court through its order dated 24.09.2024 desired such information to confirm from NADRA as it was asserted by the department that petitioner was not daughter of Sher Dil/ Kareem. Official present also states that another lady Mst. Pasandi Begum approached him for issuance of pensionary benefits of her deceased mother Mst. Kareema, who in fact is aged about 77 years, as she also become widow, however before this Court, no claim has been furnished on behalf of said Mst. Pasandi Begum, aged 77.

Be that as it may, having established through NADRA record that the petitioner is daughter of Sher Dil/ Mst. Kareema, the Respondents are directed to release pensionary benefits permissible under the law in favour of the petitioner in accordance with law, however in the meanwhile, petitioner to sign an undertaking that in case of other claim by any third party, she could compensate the same through her own resources. Petitioner is directed to submit all the documents with the concerned officer, present in Court, who ensures that all pensionary benefits admissible under the law would be paid to the petitioner within 30 days.

With these directions, instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
