4. Applicant/accused Abdul Jabbar seeks protective bail in Crime No.GO-04 of 2011, registered at Police Station ACE Hyderabad City for offence under sections 218, 409, 420, 465, 468, 471, 34 PPC r/w Section 5(2) Act-II of 1947, presently pending before the learned Special Judge, Anti-Corruption (Provincial), Hyderabad in Special Case 23 of 2017.

It is, inter-alia, contended that applicant/accused is prepared to surrender before the trial Court but apprehends his arrest as NBWs have been issued against him. Serious malafide on the part of Anti-Corruption Establishment has been alleged.

Without touching merits of the case and in order to enable the applicant to approach the concerned Court for pre-arrest bail, protective bail is granted to the applicant/accused for a period of 04 (four) days from today subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. The operation of NBWs issued against applicant shall remain suspended for 04 (four) days.

The applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the trial Court within aforesaid period. It is made clear that in case applicant/accused failed to surrender before the trial Court within aforesaid period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

This order shall cease to have its effect on expiry of 04 (four) days from today i.e. on 14.09.2020 or on the applicant's surrendering himself before the concerned Court, whichever is earlier.

The bail application stands disposed of.
